


FIND YOURSELF AT KISSING

Our residents love our two-story Fitness Center. Kissing Tree's beautiful state-of-the-art fitness center includes spa-like locker rooms, private rooms for massages, and movement space for classes.

Upstairs, the second story offers a cardio theater as well as a full array of free weights and machines, not to mention amazing views of the Texas Hill Country. Set up a one-on-one appointment with a personal trainer or try out a group class. Popular weekly offerings include yoga, pilates, spin, stretching, Zumba, line dancing, strength training, core work, and boot camp.


